The Indian River School District has approved the use of Lord Baltimore Elementary School for the use of the Artisans Fair on Saturday, May 28, 2022. We were not able to hold our largest fund-raising event of the year for the scholarship fund in 2020 or 2021 because of Covid-19.

In addition, we will be seeking volunteers to help on the day of the event.

Each year the Scholarship Committee gives two scholarships to Indian River High School seniors and three scholarships to adult students, age 25 or older, at Delaware Technical and Community College in Georgetown. Two of the three scholarships are given to nursing students and one to a non-nursing student. Typically, these students were not able to go to college after high school but are now pursuing higher education to better their lives.

Our Dine and Donate in November at Northeast Seafood Kitchen was very successful. We took in \$2,197.60, the most we have raised at this event. This included proceeds from the silent auction golf package, the 50-50 cash raffle, the basket auction, the Northeast Seafood Kitchen contribution and some cash donations.
